Re: Daytona Roar Drivers' Helmet Inspections

---

For the 2020 Daytona Roar, all drivers' helmets MUST be inspected and have a 2020 Helmet sticker applied by IMSA officials prior to participation in on-track activity.

- The 2020 Helmet sticker identifies a helmet meets the FIA 8860 standard and is equipped with either the Eject System or Stand 21 "Lid Lifter" systems. The helmet inspection does not address the safety condition of the helmet.
- Helmet inspection stations are established during specific hours below in both the Yellow and Blue garages to allow all drivers opportunity to meet above requirements:
  - Thursday, January 2<sup>nd</sup> 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. in the Blue Garage near Michelin Pilot Challenge Tech area
  - Thursday, January 2<sup>nd</sup> 1:30 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. in the Yellow Garage near WeatherTech Tech area
  - Friday, January 3<sup>rd</sup> 7:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. in the Blue Garage near Michelin Pilot Challenge Tech area
  - Friday, January 3<sup>rd</sup> 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. in the Yellow Garage near WeatherTech Tech area
- If a driver is unable to meet the above scheduled times due to travel, IMSA Officials will be available to provide helmet inspections on a case by case basis.
- All other protective safety equipment used by a driver or a race team remains the responsibility of the entrant and will be spot checked during IMSA events.
