13. Pit Lane Equipment: Teams are permitted to use only One (1) 10' x 20' EZ Up type canopy in the pit box per entered Car. No other

tent or awning structures permitted. Hard panels inside the tent and/or flooring are prohibited. The following

procedures must be adhered to on pit lane and within the pit lane area:

 The paved area behind the pit boxes back to the pit tower structure must remain a clear fire lane at all times. Heaters of any type prohibited.

The fire marshal requires a doorway in the rear tent wall of a minimum four (4) feet wide that must remain open at all times. This

doorway shall meet the requirements for this Event per Article 3.16.4.A of the IMSA IWSC Sporting Regulations.
