Re: Scrutineering Declaration – Online Form

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To aid social distancing and minimize the time necessary for Safety Inspection of Cars during an Event, IMSA is launching an online tool to declare critical Car safety equipment information. This information is required to be completed as part of the Scrutineering Declaration for IMSA Prototype Challenge Participants. Entrants must also present the Car(s) to the designated area at the scheduled time during an Event for a revised safety inspection process.

Completion of the Scrutineering Declaration is mandatory for IMSA Prototype Challenge Entrants and must be completed a minimum of 24 hours prior to load-in for an Event. Safety equipment and its respective installation on a Car remains the responsibility of the Entrant and is subject to random check(s) during IMSA Events.

The 2020 Scrutineering Declaration Form can be found by selecting Tech Declaration under the Entries tab in MERG (merg.imsa.com)

Prior to completing the Scrutineering Declaration for the next event, please gather the Serial Number, SFI/FIA rating and/or expiration for the of applicable safety, fuel, and scrutineering logger items including the following examples:

1. Chassis/VIN Number
2. Engine Number
3. Engine Mileage
4. ECU Number
5. ELB Number
6. Safety Belts
7. Seat
8. Fuel Cell
9. Fire Extinguisher

Once submitted for the first Event, this information will pre-populate Scrutineering Declarations for future Events. It remains the responsibility of the Entrant to ensure the accuracy of data for future Events when forms have been pre-populated.
