Re: 2021 Daytona Roar/Rolex 24 Drivers' Helmet Inspections

For the 2021 Daytona ROAR and Rolex 24 Hour Events, all Drivers' helmets MUST be inspected and receive a 2021 IMSA Helmet sticker applied by IMSA Officials prior to participation in on-track activity.

- The 2021 IMSA Helmet sticker identifies only that a helmet meets the required FIA 8860 standards and is equipped with either the Eject System or Stand 21 "Lid Lifter" system. The helmet inspection does not address the safety condition of the helmet.
- Helmet inspection stations are established during specific hours below in both the Yellow and Blue garages to allow all Drivers the opportunity to meet the inspection requirement:
 - Thu., Jan. 21, 10:00 am - 12:00 pm, Yellow Garage near WeatherTech Tech area
 - Thu., Jan. 21, 1:30 pm - 3:00 pm, Blue Garage near Michelin Pilot Challenge Tech area
 - Fri., Jan. 22, 7:00 am - 9:00 am, Blue Garage near Michelin Pilot Challenge Tech area
 - Fri., Jan. 22, 10:00 am - 11:00 am, Yellow Garage near WeatherTech Tech area

For a Driver unable to meet these scheduled times due to travel, IMSA Officials will be available to provide helmet inspections on a case-by-case basis by request.

All other protective safety equipment used by a Driver or a Team remains the responsibility of the Entrant and are subject to spot checks during any IMSA Event.
