- 9 - **EVENT:** Rounds 3 and 4 of the Porsche Carrera Cup North America at Circuit of the Americas are sanctioned by IMSA and held under the IMSA RULES.
- 9.4.6 - **Entries Closing:** Tue., Apr. 13, 2021. Late entries per Art. 4.3.
- 9.4.11 - **Number of Cars admitted**
 - A. Practice sessions: 50 Maximum
 - B. Qualifying sessions: 50 Maximum
 - C. Race: 50 Maximum
- 9.4.13 - **Impound:** IMSA Technical Compound in the Paddock adjacent to the exit from pit lane per the Technical Department
- 19 - **Event Logistics:** Exclusively under the direction of and assigned by IMSA. Refer to schedule for Series paddock load-in times. Team Transporters must not arrive before 8:00 am on Wed., Apr. 28 for pre-staging.
 - Staging: Stage on the North end of CotA Blvd. headed south towards Tunnel 2 (between Tunnel 2 and Elroy Rd). When the North end is full, staging will commence on the South side of Tunnel 2 headed North. CotA staff direct and manage the process.
 - Load-In: Drivers must be at truck and monitoring CB channel 40, no later than 30 minutes prior to load-in start.
 - Load-Out: Teams must vacate the Paddock no later than 12:00 pm Mon., May 3.

- 3.7.2 - **Driver Deadline/Fee:** CoB Tue., Apr. 13. Until CoB Fri., Apr. 23, an expediting fee is charged. No applications (or related documents) processed after CoB Fri., Apr. 23.
- 4.3.6 - **Event Confirmations:** Event Confirmation Declarations must be submitted via MERG no later than 4pm Mon., Apr. 19. \$500 is charged for late Declarations or Driver changes made after this deadline until the close of Sporting Checks. Driver changes after close of Sporting Checks per Art. 11.2.1.A.
- 9.4.14.A - **Fuel Schedule:** The VP depot is located in the paddock at the fueling island between main and upper paddock. VP will deliver fuel to each Team's Paddock location.
 - A. **Roster Deadline:** Corporate Member COVID Event Rosters are due by Fri., Apr. 23 by 5:00 pm est.
 - B. **Screening Process:** Screening is required for all PCCNA participants and is conducted at the Paddock entry (walk-up). Participants must have their QR code ready for scanning along with their annual credential or SEC visible when approaching the screening area on their first day at the track. Participants must not enter their Team Paddock until successfully completing the screening process and receiving the Event sticker. Participants are only screened once during the Event week but must display the Event sticker daily. Participants must report any changes related to developing COVID-19 symptoms to IMSA Medical Liaison staff and/or appropriate IMSA PCCNA management.
 - C. **IMSA Transporters:** The IMSA Transporters will be accessible. Please enter the doors labeled "in" and "out" appropriately, and follow all Instructions listed outside the transporters. While waiting to enter, please respect social distancing outside of the transporters. Please keep crew member visits to a minimum.
