During the first ten (10) hours of the Sebring 12H Race, each LMP3 Car must complete one (1) mandatory stop (in their pit box or behind the wall) of a minimum of four (4) minutes duration, measured from pit-in loop to pit out loop (PLSL). The pit stop may take place under green flag or FCY conditions (all Sporting Regulations apply). **Penalty:** Under one (1) second short, Warning; One (1) second to fifteen (15) seconds short, Drive-Through; Over fifteen (15) seconds short, Stop plus 2X time short. Slowing and/or stopping in the pit lane to achieve time is prohibited. **Additional Penalty:** Drive-Through.

Maximum of three (3) persons per stand. Arrangements and access exclusively through SIR, Sue Calderone, scalderone@sebringraceway.com or 863-655-7701. No access to infield or Paddock.
14. **Facility Restrictions:** Off road vehicles including ATVs, ATCs, personal golf carts or bicycles prohibited. Dumping or hoses into any storm drains prohibited. Unauthorized hookup to electrical or water prohibited. Antenna masts fastened to track property prohibited. Trash bin pickup times are 10:00 am, 4:00 pm and 8:00 pm daily. Place bins at yellow line please. Fuel storage under pit lane permanent structure is prohibited.
15. **Parking Procedure:** From Tue. Mar. 15, all parking must use the Ullmann / IMSA Competitor lot outside the back straight (accessed from Gate 4). The Ullmann / IMSA Competitor lot has a cold-track pedestrian crossover directly to the Paddock, available whenever Cars are not on track, and shuttles/trams operate from Wed. Mar. 16 per schedule below. Trams go directly from the Ullmann / IMSA Competitor Lot to the transfer hub behind the Sebring Administration Bldg., where individuals transfer to a tram to the Competitor Paddock. Individuals requiring credentials before entering Paddock must go to Registration before parking. Individuals with a 2022 Annual Credential, a single event credential (SEC), or a 2022 Annual parking pass are permitted to park in the Ullmann / IMSA Competitor Lot without an additional parking pass. Each IWSC Entry receives one (1) Lot B infield parking pass, and each IMPC and PCCNA Entrant receives one (1) Lot G infield parking pass (see map), valid from Wed. through Sat. (available from 8:00 am on Tue. Mar. 15 at IMSA Registration). Additionally, each IWSC Entry receives three (3) paddock parking passes valid only on Fri. and Sat. (distributed at the Team Manager briefing) for parking in the space vacated by PCCNA team transporters. Cars in the infield or Paddock without a proper parking pass or in improper lots are towed at owner/operator's expense.
- On Sat., Mar. 19, a Public Parking Pass, specifically called "General Car Pass" is available for purchase from Sebring International Raceway for \$60. Cars with a General Car Pass are first directed to park in the track midway until that lot is full. Once the track midway is full, cars with a General Car Pass are directed to the Turn 16 area of the Paddock until that lot is full. Once the Turn 16 area is full, cars with a General Car Pass are directed to the Ullmann / IMSA Competitor lot outside the back straight. Parking in the IWSC Paddock, VIP, Media or Hospitality designated areas is prohibited.
