



RETURN TRAVEL TO UNITED STATES COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS

Return travel to United States air passenger requirements:

- **Proof of negative COVID-19 test (is required)**
 - Required for all air passengers two years of age or older (regardless of vaccination status or citizenship)
 - Viral test taken no more than one (1) day before travel by air to United States
 - Negative test must be shown to airline prior to boarding

- **Documentation of Recovery**
 - Applies if you recently recovered from COVID-19
 - Must present documentation of recovery
 - Your positive COVID-19 viral test result on a sample taken no more than 90 days before the flight's departure from a foreign country
 - And a letter from a licensed healthcare provider or a public health official stating that you were cleared to travel

Return travel to United States by land border crossings or via seaports requirements:

- **Proof of negative COVID-19 test (is not required)**
 - Proof of a negative COVID-19 is not required if returning by land crossings or seaports
