Dear Detroit Grand Prix Participants,

We look forward to hosting you on the Streets of Downtown Detroit as we gear up for the 2024 Chevrolet Detroit Grand Prix presented by Lear, May 31-June 2.

We were so proud to bring this event back to Downtown Detroit in 2023 for the first Grand Prix on the city streets in 32 years. The energy and excitement that the return of the Grand Prix brought to the city was amazing and we can't wait to build on that momentum this summer.

As we get ready for the 34th Grand Prix event hosted in Detroit, we are excited to once again showcase the nine-turn, 1.7-mile street circuit that incorporates many of Detroit's most iconic and popular areas, including Hart Plaza, the beautiful Detroit Riverfront and the GM Renaissance Center.

We know that the on-track action will continue to deliver the thrills and great racing that our fans appreciate and expect in the Motor City. Featuring three premier racing series, the lineup that will compete this summer on the Downtown circuit includes the high-powered cars of the NTT INDYCAR SERIES, the much-anticipated return of the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship and the rising stars of INDY NXT by Firestone.

One of the biggest reasons for bringing the Grand Prix back to the Streets of Downtown Detroit was to benefit businesses across the city and make more of an impact on the local economy. With a more inclusive event that featured more than half of the venue open to fans for free, the 2023 Grand Prix delivered a very positive event for Detroit and its surrounding communities.

With an estimated crowd of approximately 150,000 people over the three-day weekend, the Grand Prix's impact surpassed all expectations. An independent economic study revealed that last year's event generated more than \$104 million in total spending for the Metropolitan Detroit area – an all-time high for the Detroit Grand Prix. We look forward to hopefully raising the bar even higher in 2024, with much of the event still open and available to fans for free.

In addition to boosting the local economy, the Grand Prix is also proud to add its legacy of giving in Detroit. On Friday evening May 31, we will host the 10th annual PwC Grand Prixmiere presented by Chevrolet charity event, which has raised nearly \$7 million in charitable funds over the last nine years.

Our team is hard at work as we prepare to host all of the race weekend competitors on the Downtown street circuit and we want to make sure that everything is in order well in advance of your arrival. Enclosed you will find this year's Team Reference Guide, including team hospitality and motor coach information. We ask you to please review the guide and let us know if you have any questions. We look forward to receiving your information by the deadlines indicated in the materials.

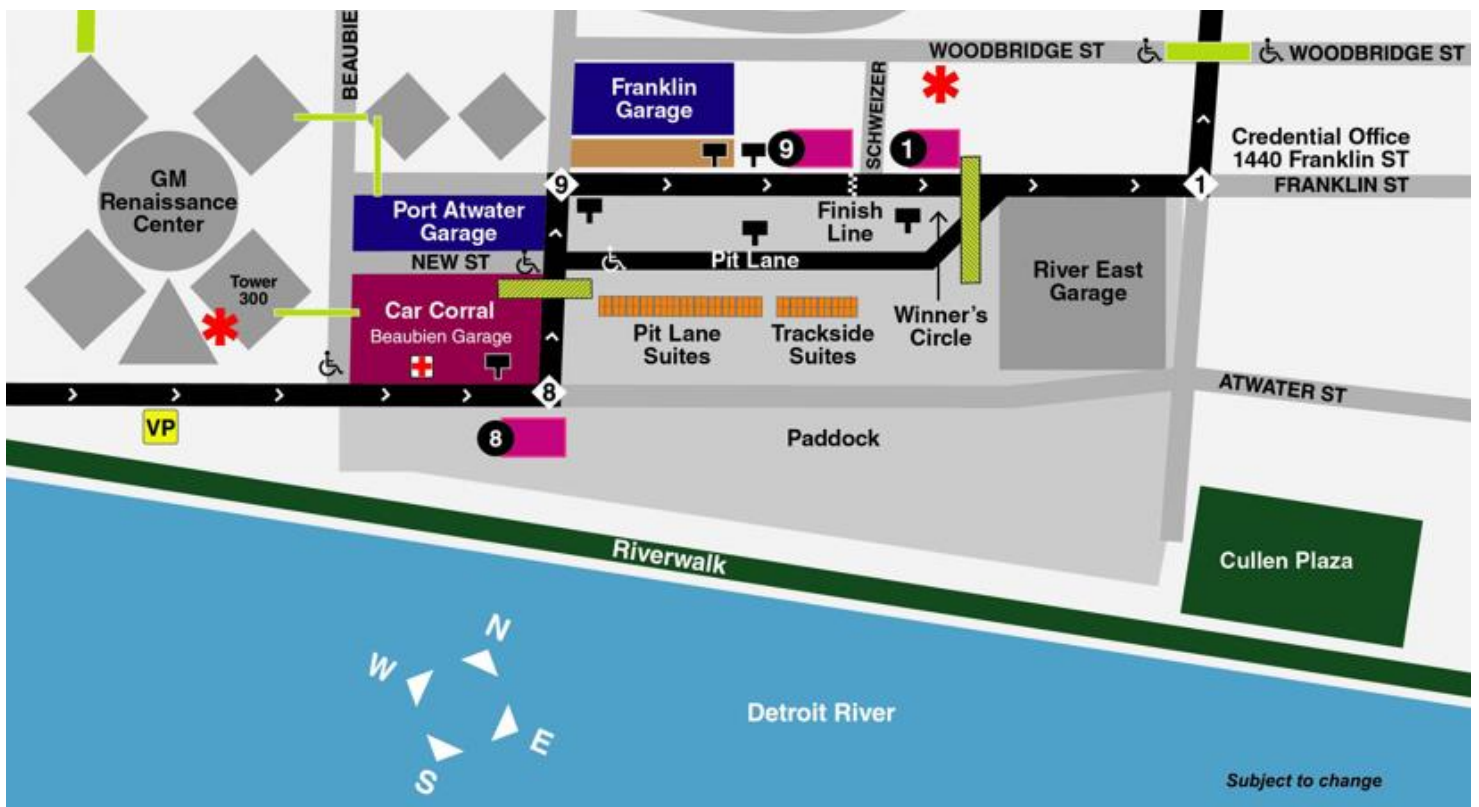

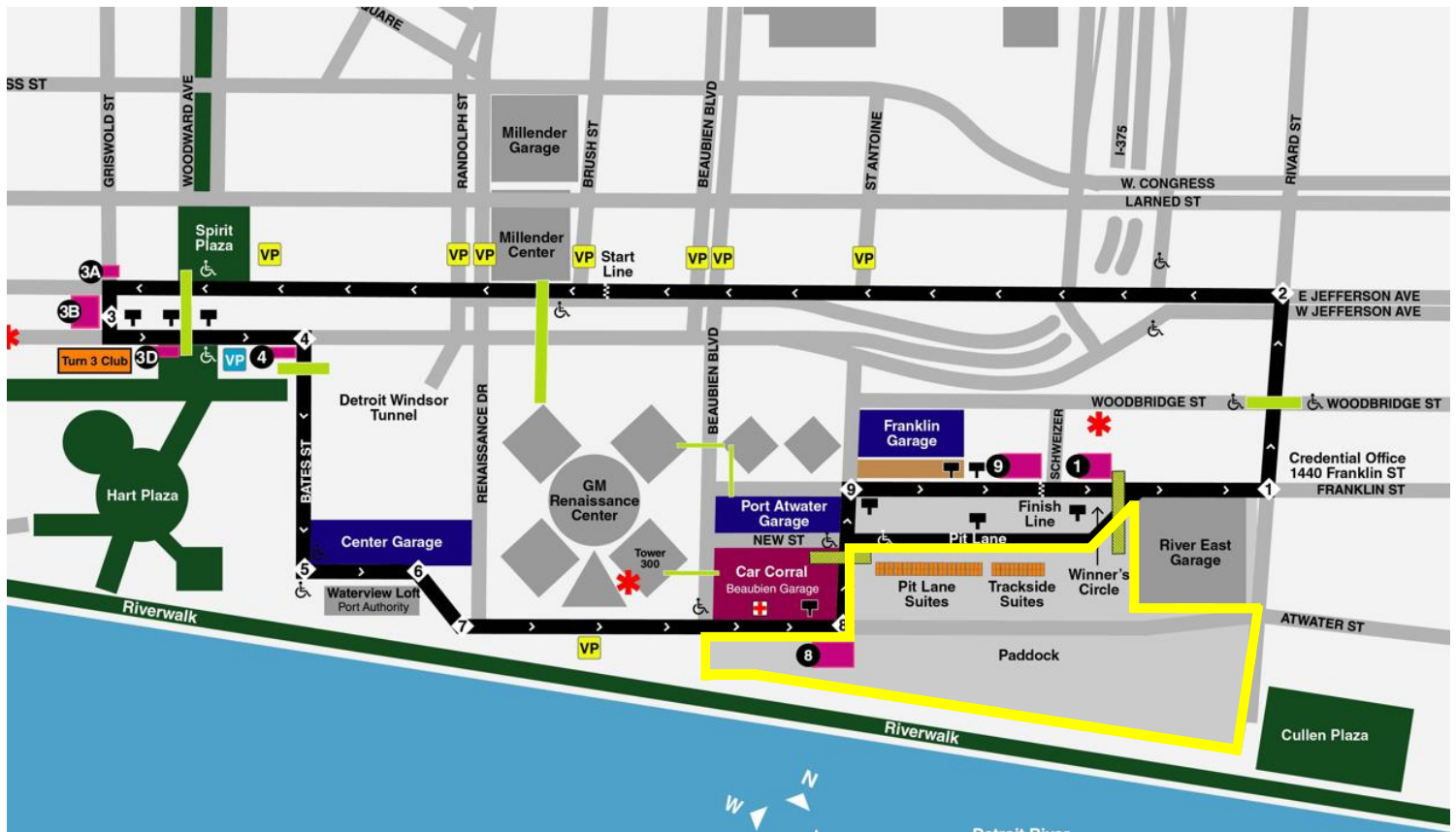
GOLF CARTS & SCOOTERS

Please refer to the yellow outline on the map below for permitted areas. Any carts or scooters within the paddock must have a Powered Cart Credential to operate. There will be a \$50.00 charge per credential requested.

1. Washing facilities will be available prior to move-in to the Fifth Third Bank Paddock at a location determined by Grand Prix Officials. A competition bulletin will be sent with these details.
2. All team transporters, motor coaches, and related equipment must vacate the Fifth Third Bank Paddock by 10:00pm Sunday evening, June 2, 2024. Note: Start time of move-out will be determined by event officials and informed to league officials but should start NO earlier than two hours following the last on-track activity.
3. This schedule will be strictly enforced.



FACILITY RULES

1. Event credentials must always be displayed. Drivers and crew are strongly cautioned not to exit the paddock area without credentials. No one will be readmitted without proper credentials.
2. Backpacks, bags and/or briefcases carried into the Detroit Grand Prix Venue by team owners, drivers or crew are subject to inspection at the discretion of Detroit Grand Prix or its law enforcement agencies and vendors.
3. All photographic, video, and digital images taken during any track event, including those featuring spectators or competitors, whether made or purchased by the Detroit Grand Prix or its affiliates, are the property of the Detroit Grand Prix and may only be used in advertising and promotional materials at its sole discretion.
4. The use of drones within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue's airspace are strictly prohibited. Anywhere outside the venue's airspace will require approval and a permit through The City of Detroit. Please contact The City of Detroit to inquire about the proper permitting.
5. Personal vehicles are not permitted in any of the Motor Coach or Hospitality areas. ONLY service vehicles, with the proper service pass, are allowed into these areas prior to track activity and after track activity each day. All team hospitality and coach staff will be required to park in a nearby parking garage (proper pass required).
6. A Certificate of Insurance, naming the Detroit Belle Isle Grand Prix, Inc. dba Detroit Grand Prix, Downtown Detroit Partnership, Inc.; The City of Detroit; The State of Michigan; General Motors LLC; Penske Corporation; Lear Corporation and their respective subsidiaries affiliates, members, partners, officers, directors, agents, trustees and employees must be presented by each team planning to operate its own golf carts and/or scooters within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue. Teams will not be allowed access into the Detroit Grand Prix Venue without a COI being on file.
7. No personal "off road" vehicles or ATVs are permitted within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue unless used for operational purposes.
8. Golf carts must be operated by a licensed driver and are not permitted outside the Paddock.
9. Generators are not permitted unless authorized and approved by Detroit Grand Prix.
10. Team Motor Coach/Hospitality spaces are not to be utilized as contest prizes nor used as part of a public promotional campaign. Hospitality space sales to third parties or individual hospitality pass sales to the public are strictly forbidden.
11. Staking awnings on the asphalt or grass is not permitted. Please use weights to secure your awnings.
12. Only pre-approved event catering permitted except for Team Hospitality Units.
13. No firearms are permitted within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue.
14. No pets, of any kind, are permitted within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue.
15. Failure to abide by these rules may result in expulsion from the premises.

PARKING PASS INFORMATION & SECURITY

Parking Passes:

- Team and crew parking will be provided, through your Series registrar, in one of the parking garages within close walking distance to the Fifth Third Bank Paddock. Participants must have an official Chevrolet Detroit Grand Prix presented by Lear parking pass to use any of the parking garages within the circuit.
- Drivers will not have the ability to park at their motorcoach due to space constraints. Parking will be within close proximity to their motor coach or team hospitality unit.
- All parking garages and passes provided will allow access in and out during track activity. Anticipate delays to and from those garages due to high traffic activity.
- Public parking options available throughout downtown.
- The Detroit People Mover, running through downtown, is available for free in 2024. [Click Here](#) for the Detroit People Mover website.
- A Service Pass will be provided to make deliveries inside the circuit prior to 7:00am or after the conclusion of on-track activities each day. Each motor coach space and team hospitality unit receives one Service Pass per each space purchased. Please contact your Series registrar for additional Service Passes or if you need one but did not purchase a space.

Security:

- The Detroit Grand Prix will be utilizing metal detection equipment prior to admitting each guest or participant. Please plan your arrival time accordingly as this may cause a slight delay in entering the venue.
- The Detroit Grand Prix provides roaming security guards overnight in event areas. Additional security is available for specific needs. If you are interested in purchasing additional security, please indicate that when you are completing the Motor Coach & Team Hospitality Order Form.

Detroit Belle Isle Grand Prix, Inc. dba Detroit Grand Prix, Downtown Detroit Partnership, Inc.; The City of Detroit; The State of Michigan; General Motors LLC; Penske Corporation; Lear Corporation and their respective subsidiaries affiliates, members, partners, officers, directors, agents, trustees and employees, shall be named as additional insured as respects general commercial liability and auto insurance. Coverage shall be **primary and non-contributory** and shall include a **waiver of subrogation** in favor of the additional insured.

- Client shall deliver a certificate that evidences insurance coverage, states that coverage is primary and non-contributory, and includes a waiver of subrogation
- General Commercial Liability -- \$5,000,000 limit per occurrence
- Auto Liability - \$5,000,000 limit per occurrence
- Statutory Workers Compensation meeting all state and local requirements, including coverage for employer liability, with limits no less than 500,000
- Insurance companies to maintain an A.M. Best rating of A- or better
- A 30-day notice of cancellation is required on all certificates

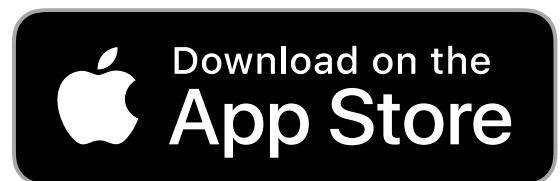


2024 DETROITGP APP
