Re: A Message From The IMSA Tech Ops Department

IMSA understands that Teams are using both TVs and RF encoders to receive the RF channels that IMSA distributes for each Event and that some Team's encoders can't pick up channels below 60MHz.

Due to this limitation and IMSA's configuration needs, Tech Ops have reconfigured the RF system to use virtual channels for the TV channels and to start the frequencies these channels ride on at 79MHz.

Teams will need to rescan their TVs and reconfigure their encoders at their next Event to pick up these changes. This should allow for consistent channels and frequencies to be maintained for the rest of the season. The general channel and frequency list for the remainder of the season is below.

Because the BSI Car onboard cameras change for each Event, the order of these cameras may change, but Tech Ops will try to keep them as consistent as possible. The official channel list is posted on the IMSA Noticeboard for each Event.
