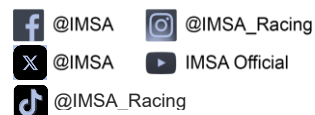

 - Load-In: Friday, March 6 at 8:00 AM. Teams must not open/unload Transporters until notified by IMSA/USAC Officials.
 - Load-Out: All Transporters must vacate by 8:00 PM on Sunday, March 8th.
- 20.2.10.- Paddock Equipment** Teams must complete the Paddock Equipment Form at merg.imsa.com no later than three (3) weeks prior to their first Event. The Paddock Equipment Form must represent the exact measurements of the transporters, awnings and any slide-outs of the trailers.
- 26.3 – Facility Damage** Competitors are responsible for any costs associated with damage to the circuit infrastructure resulting from an incident, including but not limited to Jersey Barrier Repair/Replacement, Guardrail Damage Repair/Replacement, Oil Dry Usage, etc. Competitors are invoiced directly by IMSA after the Event. Where multiple Cars are involved, costs are attributed to the Car(s) determined to be responsible for an incident. If no Car is determined responsible, costs are shared equally among all Cars involved.
- 34.1.3 – Timed Pit Stop in Race** Minimum pit time is 2.5 minutes (150 seconds).

8 – Pit/Paddock Vehicles: Racetrack Requirements: Pit vehicles must be operated by a licensed driver 16 years or more in age. Drones, bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, scooters, and other non-motorized transportation are prohibited on Sebring International Raceway property. 10 MPH speed limit for all vehicles in Paddock and pit areas.

9 – Pit Lane Equipment: Hard panels inside the tent and/or flooring are prohibited. The following procedures must be adhered to on pit lane and within the pit lane area:

- The paved area behind pit boxes to the pit tower structure must remain a clear fire lane at all times. Heaters of any type are prohibited. No more than two (2) fuel drums per Car can be stored in pit lane.

10 – Spotter Information: No additional pass necessary.

11 – Facility Rules: Fire lanes must be kept clear at all times. Used fuel drums must be removed, no barrels should be left on site. Equipment dumping or hoses draining into any storm drain is prohibited. Unauthorized hookup to electrical or water is prohibited. Antenna masts fastened to track property are prohibited. Fuel storage under the Pit Lane structure is prohibited.

12 – Parking Procedure: Infield Grass Lots, follow signage. IMSA Annual Parking Passes (Hangtags) required.

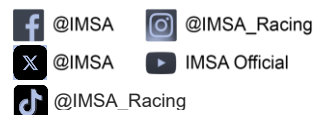
13 – Photo/Video: Licensing agreements per Art.16.7.

14 – In-Car Cameras: GPX units may be installed by GPX/USAC in LMP3 Cars for the Sebring AEC Event. Installations must respect the LMP3 Technical Regulations and Homologation and are subject to IMSA approval. GPX units must be attached to a standalone camera and only live streamed to IMSA/USAC (live streaming to the Team or any other outlet is prohibited). Additional Private In-Car Cameras per Art. 16.
