Dear Detroit Grand Prix Participants,

We look forward to welcoming all of you back to the Streets of Downtown Detroit for the 2026 Chevrolet Detroit Grand Prix presented by Lear, May 29-31.

As we prepare to host the 36th Grand Prix in Detroit, we're excited to build on the momentum of this event and add to the heritage of racing here in the Motor City. For those of you that have been part of our event since its return to Downtown Detroit in 2023, we hope you've experienced the energy and excitement that the Grand Prix brings to the heart of the city. We are proud of how this event has become one of the most welcoming and inclusive annual festivals in Detroit with more than half of the venue open and available to fans for free all weekend long. We've heard from so many sources how the Detroit Grand Prix helps the city streets come to life with the thrilling racing on the unique nine-turn, 1.7-mile street circuit that incorporates many of Motor City's most iconic and popular areas, including Hart Plaza, Spirit Plaza, the beautiful Detroit Riverfront and the Renaissance Center.

Last year, we drew the largest crowds we've had since the return to Downtown Detroit with approximately 156,000 people attending over the three-day weekend. The Grand Prix also continues to make a significant impact on the local economy with an estimated total spending of over \$100 million in the Metropolitan Detroit area each year since the event's return to its original home on the downtown streets.

In addition to the positive economic impact to the businesses in and around the city, the Grand Prix is also proud to build on its legacy of giving in Detroit. We will host the 12th annual PwC Grand Prixmiere presented by Chevrolet on Friday evening May 29 at Hudson's Detroit, the new world headquarters of General Motors. This special event has raised nearly \$10 million in charitable funds over the last 11 years and the money raised in 2026 will benefit several Detroit-area organizations including the Belle Isle Conservancy, Boys and Girls Clubs of Greater Detroit, Detroit Public Safety Foundation, Detroit 300 Conservancy and the Pope Francis Center in Detroit.

Once again featuring three of the most competitive and exciting series in motorsports – NTT INDYCAR SERIES, the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship and INDY NXT by Firestone, we know that the on-track action will continue to deliver the thrills and great racing that our fans appreciate and expect in the Motor City.

We want to ensure that everything is in order as we get ready to welcome all of the race weekend competitors back to the Downtown Detroit street circuit. 

Please refer to the purple shaded area on the map below for permitted areas. Any carts or scooters within the paddock must have a Powered Cart Credential to operate. There will be a \$50.00 charge per credential requested.

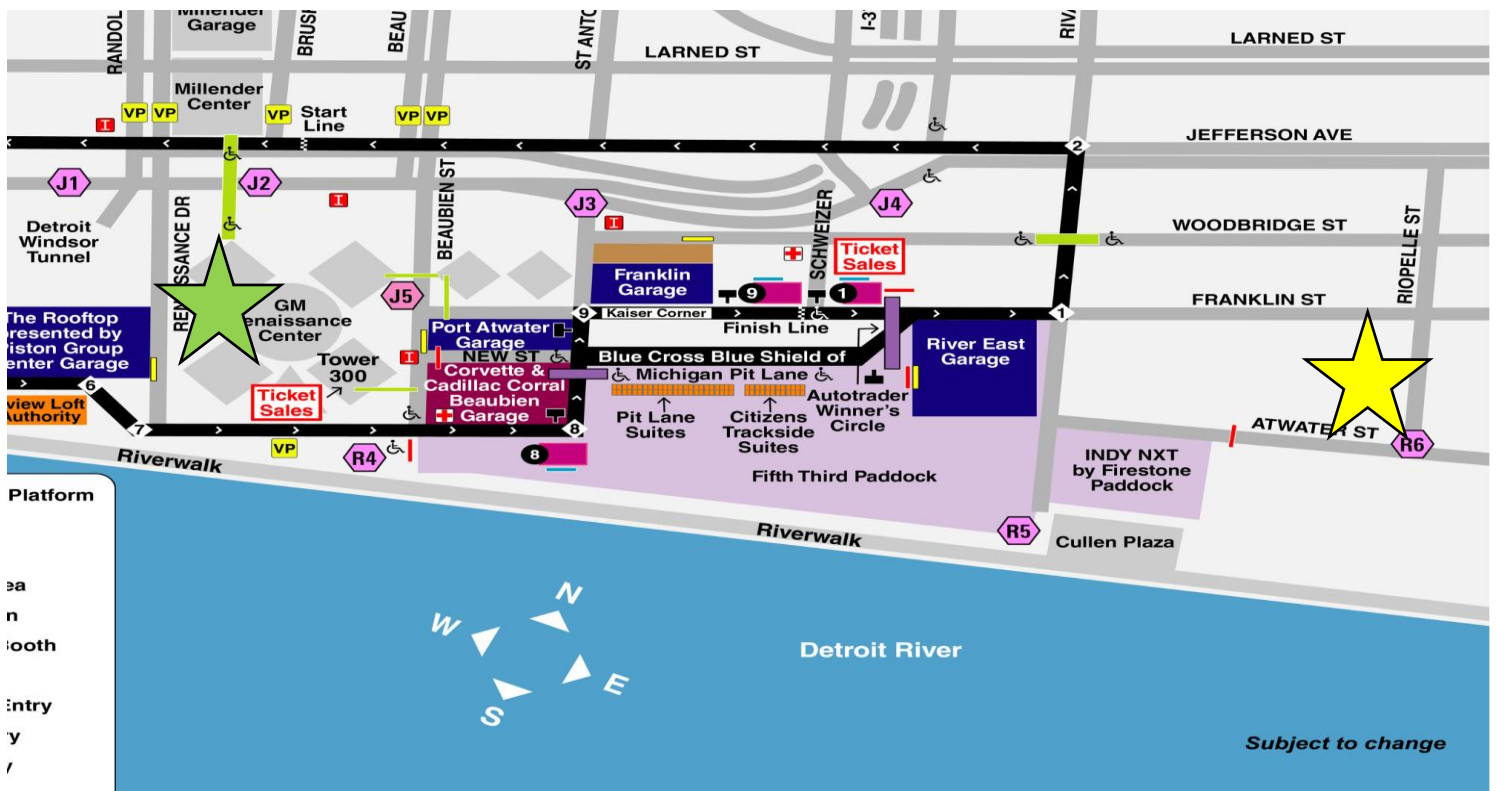

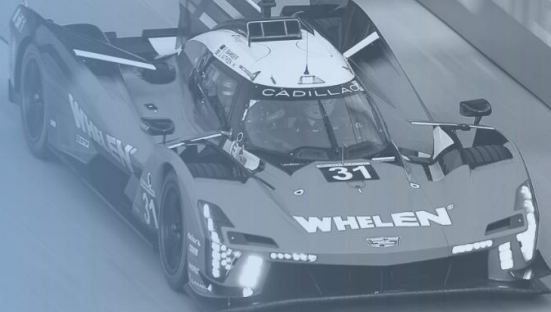

1. Washing facilities will be available prior to move-in to the Fifth Third Bank Paddock at a location determined by Grand Prix Officials. A competition bulletin will be sent with these details closer to the event.
2. All team transporters, motorcoaches, and related equipment must vacate the Fifth Third Paddock by 10:00pm each evening, May 30, 2026 (IMSA WTSCC) and May 31, 2026 (NTT INDYCAR Series & INDY NXT by Firestone). Note: Start time of move-out will be determined by event officials and informed to league officials but should start NO earlier than two hours following the last on-track activity.
3. This schedule will be strictly enforced.

FACILITY RULES

1. Event credentials must always be displayed. Drivers and crew are strongly cautioned not to exit the paddock area without credentials. No one will be readmitted without proper credentials.
2. Backpacks, bags and/or briefcases carried into the Detroit Grand Prix Venue by team owners, drivers or crew are subject to inspection at the discretion of Detroit Grand Prix or its law enforcement agencies and vendors.
3. All photographic, video, and digital images taken during any track event, including those featuring spectators or competitors, whether made or purchased by the Detroit Grand Prix or its affiliates, are the property of the Detroit Grand Prix and may only be used in advertising and promotional materials at its sole discretion.
4. The use of drones within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue's airspace are strictly prohibited. Anywhere outside the venue's airspace will require approval and a permit through The City of Detroit. Please contact The City of Detroit to inquire about the proper permitting.
5. Personal vehicles are not permitted in any of the Motorcoach or Hospitality areas. ONLY service vehicles, with the proper service pass, are allowed into these areas prior to track activity and after track activity each day. All team hospitality and coach staff will be required to park in a nearby parking garage (proper pass required).
6. A Certificate of Insurance, naming the Detroit Belle Isle Grand Prix, Inc. dba Detroit Grand Prix, Downtown Detroit Partnership, Inc.; The City of Detroit; The State of Michigan; General Motors LLC; Penske Corporation; Lear Corporation and their respective subsidiaries affiliates, members, partners, officers, directors, agents, trustees and employees must be presented by each team planning to operate its own golf carts and/or scooters within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue. Teams will not be allowed access into the Detroit Grand Prix Venue without a COI being on file.
7. No personal "off road" vehicles or ATVs are permitted within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue unless used for operational purposes.
8. Golf carts must be operated by a licensed driver and are not permitted outside the Fifth Third Paddock.
9. Generators are not permitted unless authorized and approved by Detroit Grand Prix.
10. Team Motorcoach/Hospitality spaces are not to be utilized as contest prizes nor used as part of a public promotional campaign. Hospitality space sales to third parties or individual hospitality pass sales to the public are strictly forbidden.
11. Staking awnings on the asphalt or grass is not permitted. Please use weights to secure your awnings.
12. Only pre-approved event catering permitted except for Team Hospitality Units.
13. No firearms are permitted within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue.
14. No pets, of any kind, are permitted within the Detroit Grand Prix Venue.
15. Failure to abide by these rules may result in expulsion from the premises.

PARKING PASS INFORMATION & SECURITY

Parking Passes:

- Team and crew parking will be provided, through your Series registrar, in one of the parking garages within close walking distance to the Fifth Third Paddock. Participants must have an official Chevrolet Detroit Grand Prix presented by Lear parking pass to use any of the parking garages within the circuit.
- Drivers will not have the ability to park at their motorcoach due to space constraints. Parking will be within close proximity to their motorcoach or team hospitality unit.
- All parking garages and passes provided will allow access in and out during track activity. Anticipate delays to and from those garages due to high traffic activity.
- Public parking options are available throughout downtown.
- The Detroit People Mover, running through downtown, is available for free in 2026. [Click Here](#) for the Detroit People Mover website.
- A Service Pass will be provided to make deliveries inside the circuit prior to 7:00am or after the conclusion of on-track activities each day. Each motorcoach space and team hospitality unit receives one Service Pass per each space purchased. Please contact your Series registrar for additional Service Passes or if you need one but did not purchase a space.

Security:

- The Detroit Grand Prix will be utilizing metal detection equipment prior to admitting each guest or participant. Please plan your arrival time accordingly as this may cause a slight delay in entering the venue.
- The Detroit Grand Prix provides roaming security guards overnight in event areas. Additional security is available for specific needs. If you are interested in purchasing additional security, please indicate that when you are completing the Motorcoach & Team Hospitality Order Form.



FOOD & BEVERAGE

Coverage shall be **primary and non-contributory** and shall include a waiver of subrogation in favor of the additional insured.

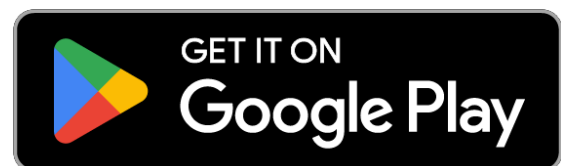
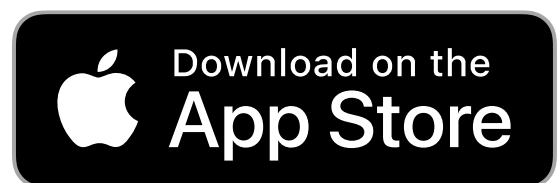
- Client shall deliver a certificate that evidences insurance coverage, states that coverage is primary and non-contributory, and includes a waiver of subrogation
- General Commercial Liability -- \$5,000,000 limit per occurrence
- Auto Liability - \$5,000,000 limit per occurrence
- Statutory Workers Compensation meeting all state and local requirements, including coverage for employer liability, with limits no less than 500,000.
- Insurance companies to maintain an A.M. Best rating of A- or better
- A 30-day notice of cancellation is required on all certificates
