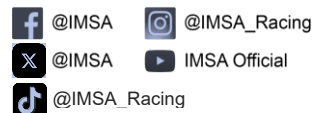

- Staging: Located in the VIR Raceplex Lot.
 - Load-In: Friday, June 19 at 8:00 AM. Teams must not open/unload Transporters until notified by IMSA/USAC Officials.
 - Load-Out: Teams must not begin to depart until Sunday, June 21 at 1:30 PM. Overnight Parking is available in the Raceplex Lot. All Transporters must vacate the property by Monday, June 22 at 8:00 AM.
- 20.2.10.- Paddock Equipment** Teams must complete the Paddock Equipment Form at merg.imsa.com no later than three (3) weeks prior to their first Event. The Paddock Equipment Form must reflect the exact measurements of the transporters, awnings and any slide-outs of the trailers.
- 26.3 – Facility Damage** Competitors are responsible for any costs associated with damage to the circuit infrastructure resulting from an incident, including but not limited to Barrier Repair/Replacement, Guardrail Damage Repair/Replacement, Oil Dry Usage, etc. Competitors are invoiced directly by IMSA after the Event. Where multiple Cars are involved, costs are attributed to the Car(s) determined to be responsible for an incident. If no Car is determined responsible, costs are shared equally among all Cars involved.

- 4.3.6 - Event Confirmations:** Event Confirmation Declarations must be submitted via MERG no later than 4pm Mon., Jun.8. \$500 is charged for late Declarations or Driver changes made after this deadline until the close of Sporting Checks.

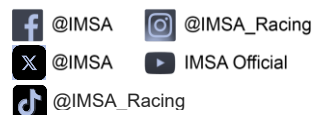


TO IMSA PARKING

- Proper credentials required for facility entry



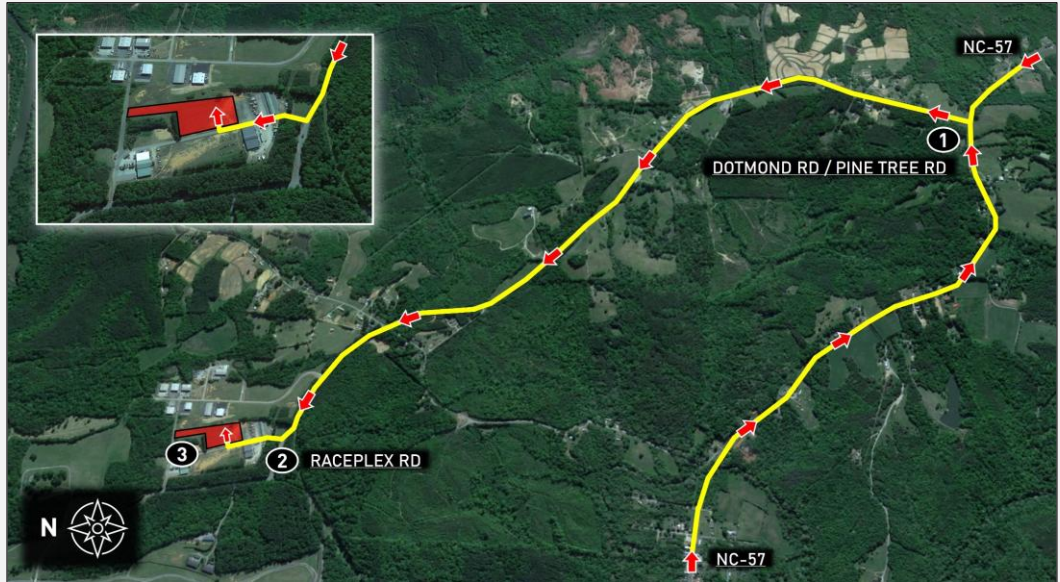




TO TRANSPORTER STAGING
